## Program Structure

The program will take place in a range of three to four years in accordance with the Outcome-Based Education (OBE) curriculum applied in the Public Administration Study Program FISIP Unpad. With the division of time as follows.

- 1st year: common basic courses, basic courses for specialized fields
- 2nd year: specialized courses
- 3rd year: specialized courses, field practice projects
- 4th year: research and final project

The curriculum used by students in the IUP Public Administration is the same as for regular students. However, students must meet proficiency in the language of instruction, namely English through a test and a minimum score of TOEFL ITP  $\geq 500$ ; TOEFL IBT  $\geq 61$ ; TOEFL CBT  $\geq 173$ ; IELTS  $\geq 6$ ; TOEIC  $\geq 575$ ; and Duolingo English Test  $\geq 100$ . Graduates from this program will receive a Sarjana Administrasi Publik (S.A.P.) or Bachelor of Public Administration (B.P.A).
