INTRODUCTION

The international undergraduate program (IUP) in International Relations, Universitas Padjadjaran, will prepare students for careers in the government and non-governmental sectors including academics, journalism, private companies, and international organizations. The program will allow students to experience an educational program with English as the Medium of Instruction (EMI), conducted and supervised by highly qualified instructors with professional backgrounds. Students will further benefit from international exposure by participating in a study abroad program for a minimum period of one semester at our partner institutions. By having the opportunity to study abroad during their program, the students benefit from experiencing the education program at partner universities, but they are also expected to enhance their cultural awareness and adaptability, as well as their language proficiency.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The International Undergraduate Program, aims to develop skills in exploring and understanding phenomena in international relations through the theory and methodology of International Relations to design an alternative solution for global, regional, national, and local issues. The program will produce graduates with international qualifications that could contribute to the increasing competitiveness of the nation at the regional and global levels. The program will also strengthen the collaboration in teaching and research between Universitas Padjadjaran and global partners across the world; therefore, it could also facilitate the two-way transfer of science, technology, and information.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Single Degree Program

- The Single Degree Program is designed for a study period of 4 years (8 semesters) within Unpad.
- Students are required to participate in at least one international exposure program, including a student exchange program, for a minimum period of one semester at the study program's partner universities abroad (during semesters 6–7).
- The maximum duration of the study period is 14 semesters (7 years).
- Graduates of this program will receive Sarjana Hubungan Internasional (S.H.Int.) or Bachelor of International Relations from Universitas Padjadjaran.
- For study completion/ graduation requirements, students should fulfill the minimum English proficiency as follows: achieve a minimum IELTS score of 6.5 (no bands lower than 6) or other internationally recognized standardized tests with comparable results.
